QUALIFICATIONS, RIGHTS AND ENTITLEMENTS OF CLASSES OF MEMBERSHIP:

The qualifications, rights and entitlements of members are set out in the Club's Articles of Association. Set out below is a summary of those qualifications, rights and entitlements.

Voting members: Only persons who are over the age of 18 years and are Catholic are eligible to be elected to Voting membership of the Club. Voting members are entitled to:

- (i) Attend and vote at all general meetings of the Club and vote in the election of the Board or any member or the Board;
- (ii) Vote on any Special Resolution including any Special Resolution to amend the Memorandum and Articles of Association;
- (iii) Subject to Articles 39(d) and 40 of the Club's Articles of Association, stand for election to the Board;
- (iv) Nominate or second any candidate for election to the Board;
- (v) Use all the social and sporting amenities and facilities of the Club.

Social Members: Only persons who are over the age of 18 years are eligible to be elected to Social membership of the Club. Social members are entitled to:

- (a) Attend at all general meetings of the Club; and
- (b) Use all of the social and sporting amenities and facilities of the Club.

However, Social members are not entitled to:

- (i) Vote at any general meeting of the Club or vote in the election of the Board or any member of the Board; or
- (ii) Stand for election to the Board;
- (iii) Nominate or second any candidate for election to the Board.

Junior members: Only persons who are under the age of 18 years are eligible to be elected to Junior Membership of the Club. A person shall not be admitted as a Junior member unless the Board:

- (a) Is satisfied that the person is joining the club for the purposes of taking part in sporting activities organised by the Club or a sporting sub-club of the Club;
- (b) Has received from that person's parent or guardian written consent to that person becoming a Junior member of the Club and taking part in the sporting activities organised by the Club or a sporting sub-club of the Club;
- (c) Is satisfied that that person will take part in regular sporting activities organised by the Club or a sporting sub-club of the Club.

Subject to the provisions of the Registered Clubs Act, Junior members are entitled to the use of such of the facilities of the Club as the Board shall determine from time to time but are not entitled to:

- (i) Attend or vote at any general meetings of the Club; or
- (ii) Stand for election to the Board;
- (iii) Nominate or second any candidate for election to the Board.

PRIVACY POLICY:

The Liverpool Catholic Club Limited ("**the Club**") is subject to provisions contained in the Privacy Act 1998 ("**the Act**").

The Act contains 10 National Privacy Principles which set out the manner in which organisations (such as the Club) must deal with personal information collected by them.

Information about the National Privacy Principles and the Act can be obtained from the Privacy Commission's website – www.privacy.gov.au

The Club takes the protection of personal information very seriously.

The National Privacy Principles require the Club to take reasonable steps to ensure a person is aware of the following information at or before the time the Club collects the personal information:

Collection of Personal Information: The Club collects personal information when:

- (a) A person makes an application for membership. In accordance with the Registered Clubs Act and the Corporations Act the Club is required to maintain a register of members containing, amongst other things, the name, address and occupation of a member. Please note: If the information is not provided, a person cannot be admitted to membership of the Club.
- (b) A member uses his or her loyalty card at the Club (including when a loyalty card is placed in a gaming machine or any other machine that is linked to the Club's loyalty system). In accordance with the Gaming Machines Act the Club is required to maintain certain information relating to the use of loyalty cards. Please note: If the information is not provided, the member is not entitled to participate in the Club's loyalty system.
- (c) A person uses the Club's website. Please note: personal information collected via the Club's website is collected in accordance with the Club's Website Policy and Website Privacy Statement which can be accessed at www.liverpoolcatholic.com.au

Disclosure of Personal Information: Personal information collected by the Club will not be disclosed to any organisation unless the disclosure is permitted, required or authorised by law.

Access to Personal Information: A person can access their personal information held by the Club by contacting the Club. Access will be provided in accordance with the National Privacy Principles.
