

By law to restrict access to Club premises

WHEREAS:

- (A) The Delta variant of COVID-19 is highly infectious and has had a devastating impact in Australia and around the world.
- (B) Article 46(b) of the Club's Constitution provides that the Board has power to make By-laws not inconsistent with the Constitution as in the opinion of the Board are necessary or desirable for the proper control, administration and management of the Club's finances, affairs, interests, effects and property and for the convenience, comfort and well-being of the members of the Club (including the control and management of the Club's premises and the privileges to be enjoyed by each category of members) and to amend or rescind from time to time such By-laws. Article 37(c) of the Club's Constitution also grants the Board the power to make By-laws from time to time regulating the terms and conditions on which guests may be admitted to the Club.
- (C) The Board is of the view that vaccination against COVID-19 is the best protection against COVID-19 and that vaccination is critical to minimising the risk of transmission and consequences of COVID-19 for staff, members, guests and other visitors to the Club.
- (D) The Club wishes to take all reasonably practical measures to protect all persons having access to the premises, facilities and amenities of the Club from contracting, or spreading, the virus, which includes restricting access to the Club's premises.

IT IS NOW HEREBY RESOLVED THAT THE BOARD MAKE THE FOLLOWING BY-LAW:

1. The Board hereby adopts the *COVID-19 POLICY FOR MEMBERS AND GUESTS* dated 7th December 2021] (**Policy**).
2. Until further decision by the Board, the only members of the Club, guests of members and visitors to the Club over the age of 16 years who can access the Club's premises are those who satisfy the conditions of entry in the Policy, as amended from time to time.
3. Any person over the age of 16 years who cannot satisfy the conditions of entry in the Policy are hereby prohibited from entering the premises and will be removed from the premises if they gain entry contrary to the Policy.
4. The Club's premises to which the Policy applies are defined in the Policy.
